## 2009 Spelling Bee rescheduled for Feb. 5

MNPS Schools-Kathryn C. Mitchell Spelling Bee, originally scheduled for Jan. 28, was cancelled due to inclement weather and has been rescheduled for Thursday, Feb. 5. Sixty-four 5th and 6th graders from 32 Metro schools will participate in the Metro Schools-Kathryn C. Mitchell Spelling Bee. The top two winners will receive trophies and prizes and will proceed to the Davidson County Spelling Bee, which will be held Tuesday, Feb. 10.

Dr. Kathryn C. Mitchell, a native of Nashville and former Metro school teacher, was significantly involved in many social and civic activities that focused on the needs of children. Through her efforts, Dr. Mitchell was instrumental in establishing the first Spelldown, known now as the spelling bee, which has been named in her honor.
