Nashville Career Fairs -Two fairs, One day

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (Feb. 9, 2008) – MNPS, Nashville Area Chamber of Commerce and Middle Tennessee State University will host the Nashville Career Fairs, Tuesday, Feb. 10, at the Tennessee State Fairgrounds. There will be two fairs taking place, *Teacher Recruitment* and *College to Career*.

During the *Teacher Recruitment Fair*, highly qualified teacher candidates will have the opportunity to meet and greet with more than 1,000 education professionals from coast to coast. Various colleges, universities and school districts, including MNPS, will be available to do on-site interviews and provide material about what they are looking for in a teacher. The *College to Career Fair* will consist of business, non-profit, industry and government representatives who will meet with candidates eager to enter the workforce.

Both fairs are open to juniors, seniors, graduate students and alumni from the participating colleges and universities of the Nashville Area Career Fair Consortium.
