MNPS announces leadership changes for three elementary schools

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (June 25, 2009) – Today, Metro Schools announced three new elementary school principal assignments. New leadership includes:

- Roxie Ross to Whitsitt from Eakin
- Dr. Carlos Comer to J.E. Moss from Caldwell
- Alison Effinger to Eakin from J.E. Moss

These changes were made to fill vacancies created through transfers of principals into new positions. All were made under the recommendation of the Associate Superintendent for Elementary Schools and are intended to put a strong leader with the right skills into the school that best fits his/her abilities, leadership style and expertise.

“Our goal is to equip every school with the right people and the right tools,” said Director of Schools Dr. Jesse Register. “We have confidence in each of these leaders and feel these placements will be beneficial to the schools and the students they serve.”
